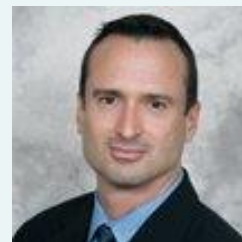


Going Global: Tips for the International Grants Professional
